PRIVACY POLICY

STATEMENT

Leather 13 Limited (further - we, us) does respect privacy of our Customers and Partners and collects as less data as possible. By ordering from us, opening an account or entering a collaboration you agree to the following terms and conditions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS POLICY

1. Data collection

1.1 For purposes of quoting, invoicing, shipping, billing, and maintaining private accounts we collect contact details of Customers and Partners such as:

- Name/s
- Shipping and billing addresses
- Email/s
- Contact phone number/s

The contact details are provided directly by our Customers and Partners or by their authorised representatives to enable us to deliver professional services or to perform due diligence checks before we agree to provide services.

1.2 Our website leather13.co.nz (further - our website) uses cookies (small text files stored in a user's browser), web beacons (electronic images that allow our website to count visitors who have accessed a

particular page and to access certain cookies), tags and scripts. Additional information on how we use cookies and other tracking technologies and how you can control these can be found in Clause 3.

2. Usage, maintenance and protection of the collected data

2.1 We use the data that we collect to provide our Customers and Partners with agreed services.

2.2 We use the data as permitted by this Privacy Policy and we do not use it for any other purposes, unless it is necessary to comply with a legal and professional right or duty or to protect our rights.

2.3 We may also use non-personal, de-identified and aggregated information for data analytics, and research.

2.4 We do not add emails to our promo mailing lists automatically without seeking your consent.

2.5 We do not disclose any personal information provided by our Customers and Partners to third parties for marketing purposes without seeking your consent.

2.6 We understand the importance of protecting children's privacy. Our website is not designed for, or intentionally targeted at, children 16 years of age or younger. If we are provided with personal information by Customers who happen to be 16 years of age or younger, we treat this information in the same way as in the Clauses above.

2.7 Our website provides links to certain merchant platforms and social media apps. We may use these platforms and apps to tag you in a post with your prior consent or as an additional way to contact you. We will not use any information we may see there in the ways other than mentioned in Clauses above, however, we have no control over the information that you leave within these platforms and apps and over their policies.

2.8 We use technological security measures including firewalls, encryption and anti-virus software to protect data stored on our electronic devices.

3. Cookie info

3.1 Our website is designed in a way that the usage data is collected automatically (see Clause 3.2). Within our business, we do not use this data for purposes other than stated in Clauses above. However, we are open to negotiations over the website design and amendments of cookies if a problem occurs from your end.

3.2 Usage data may include information such as your IP address, browser type, browser version, the pages of our website that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. The website also may remember the login/password info, language preferences and similar information.

When you access our website by or through a mobile device, it may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of the mobile device, its unique ID, IP address, mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, and other diagnostic data. It may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our website or when you access the website by or through a mobile device.

3.3 Tracking technologies such as beacons, tags, and scripts are used in our website to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our website.

3.4 You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some parts of our website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our website may use cookies.

4. Legal regulations

4.1 We comply with the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020 (as amended from time to time) (further - the Privacy Act).

4.2 Where applicable, we will also comply with data protection laws of other jurisdictions, such as the European General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

4.3 In addition to this Policy, we also include terms in our agreements with our Partners that describe how we handle personal information during the delivery of our professional services.

5. Changes to this Policy

5.5 We may modify or amend this Policy from time to time.

To indicate that the changes have been made, we will amend the revision date in the footer of this document. The new modified or amended Policy will apply from that revision date. Therefore, we encourage you to periodically review this Policy to be informed about how we are protecting your information.
